Japanese drum group "SAI" originated in a drum group at the University of Tokyo. In 2012, "SAI" won the championship in the drum contest – "*Wadaiko Contest East Japan*" sponsored by the Japan Taiko Association. Subsequently, "SAI" started its professional career in 2013 and, since then, it has been delivering its performance more than 200 times a year.

"SAI" has appeared in a lot of Japanese TV programs, commercials of famous companies such as McDonald's and Google, a latest Japanese film, and many programs and activities. "SAI" achieved a huge success in concerts in Azerbaijan and Latin American countries in 2016, and succeeded in three concerts in Iran in January 2017. There is a Japanese expression – "*dogimo o nuku*" which means "to give spectators *or* audience an astonishing experience". "SAI" promises to bring all of you "*dogimo o nuku*" moments during its performance in Malé.
